1	01 way SIC transfer from Melbourne (Tullamarine) airport to Melbourne CBD area hotel. Pick up from designated bus pick up zone.	158	128
2	Great Ocean Road Adventure with Lunch - 396L (Departs Daily: 08.00am - 07.30pm) Spectacular coastal views along the Great Ocean Road. Stop at picturesque Apollo Bay for 2 course lunch - perhaps a walk along the beach.
